RE: **Request For Information Regarding Landfill Capping Grants**

In accordance with your request to provide information regarding landfill capping grants, the Business Compliance Division has developed the attached list. This list identifies communities that have received landfill capping grants via the Landfill Capping Grant Program as authorized by St. 1983, c 723, s. 9H and amended by St. 1984, c.233, s. 9V (" the Landfill Capping Grant Program") and landfill capping grants awarded to communities in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Central Artery/ Tunnel (CA/T) Financial Assistance Grant Program. It should be noted that a number of the Landfill Capping Grant Program reimbursements are not listed here as they were awarded prior to FY 1991. Additionally, the Author could find no DEP files identifying municipalities and corresponding grant amounts for FY 1991, and although MMARS was able to identify a total of \$716,689.90 in capping grant funds reimbursed in FY 1991, no individual municipalities and corresponding grant amounts were listed.
